May 1, 2018 Republican Primary

To Fill Judicial Vacancy

Circuit Court Judge Part II, District 4

To the voters of Grainger County, Tennessee: Notice is given that due to a vacancy, the office of Circuit Court Judge, Part II, District 4, will be included in the Republican Primary election to be held on **Tuesday, May 1, 2018**. In addition to the previously noticed judicial and county offices for the May 1, 2018 primaries, the vacancy in the office of Circuit Court Judge Part II, District 4 will be included on the Republican Primary ballot.

Qualifying Deadline – Thursday, February 15, 2018 at 12:00 noon

Withdrawal Deadline – Thursday, February 22, 2018 at 12:00 noon

- The Judicial District 4 consists of Cocke, Grainger, Jefferson and Sevier Counties.
- Nominating petitions for Republican Primary candidates and Independent candidates interested in filling the vacancy may be obtained from any one of the county election commission offices.
- Republican Primary candidates and Independent candidates must file their original nominating petition in the office of the county election commission in the county of their residence and a certified duplicate in the county election commission office with the other three (3) counties included in Judicial District 4 no later than the qualifying deadline.
- Candidates interested in representing the Democratic Party for the office of Circuit Court Judge Part II, District 4 on the August 2, 2018 ballot must contact the chairman of the Democratic Party to be considered for nomination. Political party nominees, if any, must be certified to the county election commission offices no later than the same qualifying deadline.
- As previously noticed, the vacancy in the office of Circuit Court Judge Part I, District 4 will appear on both the Republican Party and Democratic Party primary ballots on May 1, 2018.
